KONARK FESTIVAL

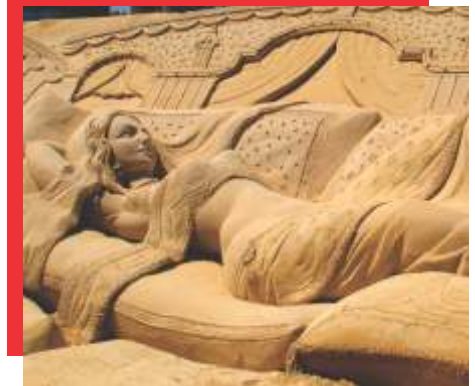
70 kms south-east of Bhubaneswar stands the Sun Temple at Konark, a World Heritage Monument popularly known as the 'Black Pagoda'. Built in 1255 AD, this celestial chariot of the mythical Sun God bears testimony to Odisha's architectural excellence.

Amidst the magnificent backdrop of this temple, the Konark Festival is organised from December 1 – 5, which will offer deep and interesting insights into the rich cultural and dance heritage of the country where classical dancers from all over India mesmerize with their scintillating performances.



International Sand Art Festival

The International Sand Art Festival is organized from December 1– 5 on the beach of Chandrabhaga, situated at a distance of 3 km from the Konark Temple.
